RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BALDWIN HILLS CONSERVANCY COMMUNICATIONS PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXPEND UP TO \$19,000 OF BHC SUPPORT FUNDS FOR EXPENDITURES PROPOSED IN THE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy (BHC) was created to acquire open space and manage public lands within the Baldwin Hills area and to provide recreation, restoration and protection of wildlife habitat within the BHC territory; and

WHEREAS, the BHC is responsible for the delivery of a \$40 million program of land acquisition, habitat restoration, site improvements and increased public access for the planned expansion of Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the BHC seeks to inform the public of the acquisitions and improvements undertaken to create a two-square-mile park and natural open space area; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy Communications Plan sets forth a six month plan for increasing public awareness of the BHC and its projects; and

WHEREAS, the BHC support budget includes funds available for public relations and outreach.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Board hereby adopts the Baldwin Hills Communications Plan and authorizes the Executive Officer to expend up to \$19,000 of BHC support funds for expenditures proposed in the plan.
