RESOLUTION 05-11

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF PROPOSITION 40 FUNDS TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, NOT TO EXCEED \$12,000, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STOCKER CORRIDOR WESTERN ENTRANCE AND TRIAILHEAD AT OVERHILL DRIVE

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 32565.5 (b) states the Baldwin Hills Conservancy (Conservancy) was created to provide for the public's enjoyment, and to enhance recreational and educational experience on public lands in the territory in a manner consistent with the protection of lands and resources in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Conservancy has already invested significantly in the acquisition, planning, and development of park lands in the Baldwin Hills area for the benefit of the greater public; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 32569 (a), the Conservancy shall administer any funds appropriated to it and any revenue generated by public agencies for the Baldwin Hills area and contributed to the Conservancy, and may expend those funds for capital improvements, land acquisition, or support of the Conservancy's operations; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 40 funds are available for capital improvements, such as the Stocker Corridor Trail and Bike Path project; and

WHEREAS, current preliminary construction requires supplemental funding to provide for permanent perimeter fencing, and regulatory signage,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy Board hereby authorizes a grant of Proposition 40 funds, not to exceed \$12,000, for the development of the Stocker Corridor western entrance and trailhead at Overhill Drive.
