RESOLUTION 06-14

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROPOSED WORK PLAN FOR COLLABORATIVE PRIORITIZATION AND FUNDING OF INTER-MODAL ACCESS AND LINKAGES BETWEEN REGIONAL DESTINATIONS AND THE BALLONA CREEK.

WHEREAS, the BHC was created to acquire open space and manage public lands within the Baldwin Hills area, and to provide recreation, restoration and protection of wildlife habitat within the Conservancy territory; and

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 32565, subdivision (f) (1) instructs the BHC to use Baldwin Hills Park Master Plan as the conceptual guide for planning and acquisition of additional recreational and open space; and

WHEREAS, the Ballona Creek Trail and Bikeway currently has physical barriers preventing efficient access to and from city, county, state and private resources situated adjacent to the creek; and

WHEREAS, the BHC recognizes the importance of connecting regional destinations through a inter-modal linkages in order to expand access and recreational opportunities to the millions of California residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the BHC may award grants to state, federal and local governments, public agencies or non-profits for the purposes of its division pursuant to Chapter 428 of Division 22.7 section 32569 of the California Public Resources Code; and

WHEREAS, the funding for implementing the work plan is available from the collaborative planning and development grant agreement (BHC2004) administered by Environment Now, a non-profit organization.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Baldwin Hills Conservancy hereby adopts the proposed work plan for collaborative prioritization and funding of inter-modal access and linkages between regional destinations in the Ballona Creek.
