RESOLUTION 04-09

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A QUALIFIED CONTRACTOR, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000, TO PROVIDE TRAIL PREPARATION AND HABITAT RESTORATION SERVICES WITHIN THE BHC TERRITORY.

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Conservancy (BHC) was created to acquire open space and manage public lands within the Baldwin Hills area and to provide recreation, restoration and protection of wildlife habitat within the Conservancy territory; and

WHEREAS, the BHC may undertake site improvements; regulate public access; re-vegetate and otherwise rehabilitate degraded areas in consultation with other public agencies with appropriate jurisdiction and expertise pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 32568; and

WHEREAS, the BHC's two-square mile territory is described in Public Resources Code Section 32553 (a); and

WHEREAS, the BHC has identified a number of projects within the territory that can create a positive impact for visitors to Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the BHC authorizes the Executive Officer to negotiate and enter into an agreement, not to exceed \$15,000, for trail preparation and habitat restoration within the BHC territory.
