RESOLUTION 04-10

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A QUALIFIED CONTRACTOR, TO PROVIDE \$10,000 IN GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS (GIS) MAPPING AND GRAPHIC DESIGN SERVICES FOR MEASURING AND EVALUATING PARK USAGE IN THE BALDWIN HILLS

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 326555 states the Baldwin Hills Conservancy (BHC) was created to provide for the public's enjoyment, and to enhance recreational and educational experience on public lands in the territory in a manner consistent with the protection of lands and resources in the area; and

WHEREAS, the BHC may conduct any necessary planning activities in accordance with the purposes set forth in its division pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 32565.5 (b); and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Park Master Plan was adopted by the BHC as the guiding document for the expansion of Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, a baseline of data and information must be compiled and catalogued to aid the BHC in measuring and evaluating park usage in the Baldwin Hills for future planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, GIS mapping links research data with graphic images for analysis and presentation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the BHC authorizes the Executive Officer to negotiate and enter into an agreement, not to exceed \$10,000, for GIS mapping and graphic design services in for measuring and evaluating park usage in the Baldwin Hills.
