RESOLUTION 06-09

RESOLUTION BY THE BALDWIN HILLS CONSERVANCY (BHC) IN SUPPORT OF THE SAFE DRINKING WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION ACT OF 2006 (PROPOSITION 84)

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills represent the last large open space in the 127 square mile Ballona Creek Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the BHC was created to acquire open space and manage public lands within the Baldwin Hills area and to provide recreation, restoration and protection of wildlife habitat within the BHC territory; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 84, is a \$5.4 billion bond measure slated for the November 2006 statewide ballot that would provide critically needed funding to ensure the availability of safe drinking water, improve local water supply reliability, strengthen flood protection, and preserve California's natural landscapes, including parks, lakes, rivers, beaches, bays, ocean and coastline; and

WHEREAS, continued funding for capital outlay projects is essential to the BHC achieving its mission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Board of the BHC hereby supports the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Act of 2006 (Proposition 84).
